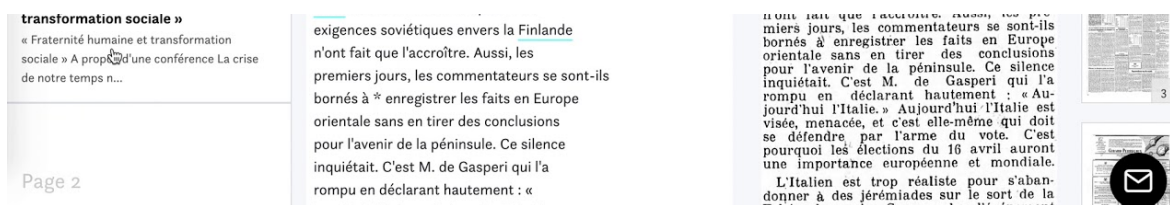
## Alpha release of the impresso interface published

Dear all,

we are excited to announce the Alpha Release of the impresso interface. It is still very much work in progress but it already has the basic functionalities you expect from an interface for digitized historical newspapers. You will also find a few advanced features in early stage of development.

*We want to encourage you to try things out and leave us your feedback: What do you like? What do you miss? What is it that you do not like? What is broken?*

## About this alpha release

This release is still a bit rough around the edges, expect bugs, sometimes slow performance and imperfections.

What we have included:

- The basic version of the interface with 22 Swiss newspapers, mainly in French
- Named entities (persons, locations)
- Topic models and Topic model explorer
- Collection management
